## 2 Audit objectives

The objectives of this forest management surveillance audit are:

1. Follow-up by ASI on compliance with major and minor corrective action requests proposed following the ASI 2006 FM surveillance audit in June 2006, at Wijma Douala in Cameroon (ASI-REP-54-BVQI-2006-Cameroon).
2. This ASI audit was prepared to check compliance in the field with all the outstanding corrective action requests so that the suspension of accreditation for BV in Cameroon could be reconsidered.

## 3 ASI stakeholder consultation process

ASI informed all FSC members, FSC NIs, and FSC CBs of this surveillance audit but did not perform a thorough stakeholder consultation process as the objective of this surveillance audit was to follow-up on previous outstanding corrective action requests. However, a number of NGOs were invited to participate as observer to this BV surveillance audit and one stakeholder sent some comments to both BV and ASI.

The following NGOs were invited to participate as observers during this surveillance audit but declined the invitation:

- Greenpeace.
- WWF.
- Friend of the Earth.
- CED.
- Forest People.

Stakeholder comments	ASI response
The village of Bidjap currently has agriculture fields in the FMU Issue regarding Tya assono and the community forest (SAGED/AFSONO).	BV followed-up with the Comité de Suivi to ensure that it was working adequately. This follow-up indicated that the Comité de Suivi was functioning to the satisfaction of the local communities. It is accepted that the demarcation of the UFA at Bidjap is in the hands of the administration.
Logs left near Tom and GPS points provided by national NGOs.	BV followed-up on the GPS points provided by the national NGO, as indicated below.
One NGO sent to BV a film and a report presenting GPS points where it was stated that unmarked logs had been abandoned in the concession, and that evidence of illegal activities could be witnessed; "sciage sauvage" (illegal sawing in the forest).	The certificate holder provided BV with a new film and a report to respond to the film and report of the NGO. BV investigated and followed-up on these issues. The evidence provided by the NGO and the company was evaluated in the field by BV and one ASI auditor went with BV to review some of the evidence in the field. Marginalisation of communities	The ASI team has not been presented with any letter from local communities complaining of their marginalisation by Wijma. No evidence of such marginalisation could be found during the audit.
Illegal activities of 3 <sup>rd</sup> parties	BV audit team followed-up on the measures taken by Wijma to monitor illegal activities by 3 <sup>rd</sup> parties. At the time of the audit, the measures adopted and implemented by the company were in conformity with FSC certification requirements.
Management of Azobe and harvesting rates	BV investigated this issue and proposed a corrective action request to ensure that appropriate data is included in the company's public summary report.
Compliance with Principle 9	During this surveillance audit, BV audit team thoroughly evaluated compliance with Principle 9 and proposed a major corrective action request.

Nonconformity	At the time of this ASI surveillance audit BVQI had not contacted all relevant national stakeholders and had not responded to stakeholders to inform them on how the concerns they raised had been taken into account for the certification of Wijma Douala (EUR-FM/COC-051201).

Based on the work done by the BV audit team to address the issues raised by ASI and the outcome of this ASI audit, the ASI auditor recommends reinstating accreditation for Bureau Veritas Certification in Cameroon.
